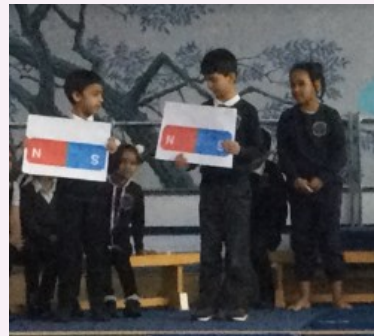
A visit to Southfields Library
